ASTON, Del. - There are people out there who like to complain about the government and do nothing about it.

Then, there is Dan Prasalowicz. He's a small business owner who is so fed up with Congress that he started his own public crusade to vote out every member of the House and Senate.

Oh, by the way, he also wants to run for president.

Fox 29's Chris O'Connell spoke to the Delaware resident who says enough is enough.

You don't have to talk to Prasalowicz to find out he's angry. His frustration is written all over his Aston business.

The banner hung outside along busy Concord Road highlights the \$13-trillion national debt and calls for Congress to be fired.

He's so disappointed with lawmakers that he wants to "Get Rid of the Bums," his sign says.

Prasalowicz also has a website, DebtorsRebellion.com, he wrote a book *¿* not to complain but to offer answers, he says.

He wants term limits for the House and Senate, a Constitutional amendment for a balanced budget, and presidential line-item veto power.

He's a Republican but says not a Tea Partier. He wants to run the country like he runs his floor finishing business that, even in a recession, has grown into an international franchise with 110 locations *¿* despite the fact he never went to college.

Prasalowicz says he's just doing and saying what everyone else is thinking, and he says most of the reaction of his protest has been positive.
